

**Meeting with Glenn Carter**

Commissioner Fund and Commissioner Jackson discussed the feasibility seeking legal counsel from Glenn Carter regarding a recent funding request.

Glenn said that in 2011 or 2013, the county abolished the existing flood control zone district and created one for the Chehalis River. He said he didn't believe one was created for the Cowlitz River.
