Jonathan Meyer said he is proposing a two- or three-month contract with Janelle Kambich at a rate of \$50 per hour, noting that her departure during the COVID-19 pandemic left little time to train her successors.

Becky Butler asked if Janelle would have to have a 1099. Steve Wohld said Janelle also may have to pay self-employment taxes. The group said they would research the questions and work on a proposal for April 6.
