Commissioner Swope made a motion to add to the day's Business Meeting agenda Resolution 21-013: Concurring in the Lewis County Superior Court's Contract with CORE Health for Substance Use Disorder & Behavioral Health Treatment for Lewis County Drug Court & Family Recovery Court programs. Commissioner Pollock seconded.

Eric Eisenberg discussed the proposed contract.
