Glenda Forga said both the profit and loss report and the COVID report show updates from the AAA. The total income for the Lewis County Seniors Group is \$267,913. LMTAAA revenue showing on the P & L report is for October, November, and December of 2020 and the FEMA revenue is from November and December 2020. Glenda said the thrift store is performing very well. Colonel Averill said they will be scheduling a review for the Lewis County Seniors budget.

Colonel Averill said the meals to trunk delivered to 350 seniors in March and provided 164 direct deliveries to seniors in March.

Glenda Forga said the Lewis County Seniors Group recently applied for a grant to fund people to work at the senior centers through PacMTN. PacMTN would carry the contracts and provide labor to the Lewis County Seniors. Glenda had also recently applied for Building Communities Fund Grant. This is a Commerce grant that provides 25% of the funding needed to complete the Capital Improvement Project.
