Napavine UGA Discussion

If the County wants to invoke this annexation a response needs to be sent by October 19, 2015.

There was discussion on starting the process of an interlocal with the City of Napavine.

The consensus with the group was not to send the Napavine Annexation to the Boundary Review Board.

Lee will write a letter for the BOCC to sign regarding the annexation.

Lee discussed a letter that was received from the Farm Bureau regarding the VSP Program. She would like to hire a person for this. Lee thinks her department can start the work before money is taken for a contract. Once the contract is started it needs to be completed in 6 months.
