Becky Butler said Superior Court wants two armed guards.

The group discussed the possibility of a bag scanner in addition to armed security.

Becky Butler said it's likely the county could contract out for two armed guards for the same costs associated with hiring one deputy.

Becky said PEBB's increase likely will be 4.9 percent.
