Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve Resolution 20-171 to extend adjustments made to county operations in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Erik Martin said he is reviewing an updated draft of the Back to Work policies and procedures.

JP Anderson discussed the county's planned response to Gov. Inslee's plan requiring nursing home workers to undergo COVID-19 testing.

JP Anderson said the state may soon release information outlining how counties can request a variance for Phase 3.
