Becky Butler has an amendment summary including increases to the SWWF and a Law Library increase. Lewis County applied for two small grants for AOC.

The current MOU with Lewis County Seniors expires in December. Becky said matching funds of \$50,000 will be needed to get the FEMA extension for Lewis County Seniors. Commissioner Fund said she was fine with the agreement and Commissioner Stamper said it was important to help LC Seniors. Commissioner Jackson agreed. Meja said this will provide tremendous help to fund the Lewis County Seniors. Commissioner Stamper has requested timely submittal of receipts for future request for reimbursements from the Lewis County Seniors.
