Commissioner Pollock made a motion to add to the day's Business Meeting agenda the following:

- **Resolution 21-026:** Reject all bids for the material purchase of rock for the 2021 3R program.
- **Resolution 21-037:** Approve the use of the Southwest Washington Fairgrounds by Lewis County Public Health and Social Services as a COVID-19 vaccination site.

Commissioner Swope seconded.
