

Coroner Update

Warren McLeod said 2021 had 907 total cases including:

- 2 homicides
- 13 suicides
- 41 accidental deaths
- 10 undetermined deaths, 2 cases pending
- 24 drug overdoses with 2 cases pending.

Warren said these cases resulted in 68 autopsies.

There are 95 cases for 2022 including:

- 1 suicide
- 3 accidental deaths

Warren said goals for his office during 2022 include being reaccredited and to have four staff members become American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigators (ABMDI) nationally accredited/certified.

Warren said the Coroner's Office currently has 12 employees and 5 reserve deputies.
