Jail HVAC project update: Millig Vice President of Business Development Lauren Donley provided an update on the Jail HVAC project. Lauren said Millig is ahead of schedule, under budget and has a perfect safety record to date. Lauren said the project is 70 percent complete. She said Millig expects to return more than \$100,000 to the county.

GMP: The commissioners said they would like to review the county's contract with GMP to see what performance measures have or have not been met. Daleyn Coleman said the contract stipulates that the candidates can seek reimbursement for travel expenses.
